

Borrow a University laptop

A number of laptops are available for you to borrow from The Murray Library and St. Peter's Library. Office 2010, Internet Explorer, Firefox, SPSS, and Adobe Software are installed. The laptops are also wireless enabled.

Before you can borrow a laptop you must first book one, using the [Book a Laptop Online](#) service. Always ensure that you are aware of the return date and time before you borrow a laptop. The laptop must be returned to the library it was borrowed from, by the person who borrowed it. Make sure that the laptop is returned on time as considerable fines are charged for late return.

Please ensure that you are aware of the Terms and Conditions for borrowing a laptop and that you understand that you will be responsible for covering the costs of repair or replacement if a laptop is damaged whilst in your care or unreturned. Please make sure that you never leave a laptop unattended and that you are sensible when travelling to and from campus with your laptop, especially at night.
