

# Transcripts

Your Transcript is your official results record. On this document you will see a list of modules taken and marks achieved throughout each stage of the programme.

Current students and recent graduates will be able to view, print and download a copy of their transcript from eVision (instructions on how to do this are in the FAQ section below).

For past students, transcripts will normally be available for those who completed courses after 2002. These can be order via the [online shop](#). We will aim to process orders within two weeks.
